Safe Needle Disposal – Call Cape Regional Medical Center at (609) 463-2491. Do not dispose of needles in the trash or recycling.

<u>Plastic Bags</u> can be returned to Supermarkets for Recycling.

<u>Compact Florescent Bulbs</u> MUST be recycled as they contain Mercury.

### GUIDE TO **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING**



- Newspapers with inserts
- Office Papers
- Junk Mail
- Shredded Paper (in a clear plastic bag)
- Brown Paper Bags

- Magazines
- Telephone and Paperback Books
- Cardboard and CLEAN Pizza Boxes
- Gift, Shoe, Tissue and Powered Detergent Boxes
- Dry Food Boxes (Cereal, Cracker, Pasta, etc.)

  Remove all liner bags.
- Beer and Soda Carriers
- Non-Foil Wrapping Paper



- Food and Beverage Containers (Margarine Tubs, Microwave Trays, Yogurt Containers, etc.)
- Health, Beauty and Cleaning Product Containers
  - Other Rigid Plastic Containers including: Buckets and Landscape Pots (Five (5) gallons in size or less)

## Food and Beverage Glass Containers including:

- Clear
- Green
- Brown Bottles, Jars and Jugs

## Food, Beverage and Aerosol Cans:

- Aluminum
- Steel (Tin)

(Five (5) gallons in size or less)

#### **DO NOT RECYCLE**

- Food Contaminated Boxes
  - Styrofoam Packaging
- Polystyrene Egg Cartons
- Wax-Coated Cardboard Boxes
  - Window Glass
  - Beverage Cups
    - Paint Cans
    - PVC Pipes
    - Light Bulbs
  - Plastic bags
- Any items that contained chemical or hazardous products
