

APPLYING FOR A MARRIAGE OR CIVIL UNION LICENSE
IN MIDDLE TOWNSHIP
APPOINTMENTS ARE NEEDED

Where to apply –

The Marriage or Civil Union license shall be issued by the licensing officer in the municipality in which either party resides and is valid in any municipality in the State of New Jersey or if neither party is a resident of the State, in the municipality in which the proposed Marriage or Civil Union is to be performed and the license is valid only in the municipality and must be marked as such.

When to apply –

At least one full week before ceremony. Registrar will not issue License sooner than 72 hours after application is made.

What to Bring –

Both parties are to bring Birth Certificate (or Passport), Social Security Card, Photo ID (such as Drivers License), proof of residency and proof of dissolution of any former marriage or civil union. The fee is \$28.00 and must be cash or Money Order.

If under 18 years of age – Consent of both parents is needed.

If under 16 years of age – Parental and judicial approval is necessary.

Where Marriage or Civil Union Record will be Filed – Person performing marriage or Civil Union ceremony must file Marriage or Civil Union Certificate with the Registrar of the municipality in which the marriage or civil union was performed.
