7. ORDINANCE NO. 1365-10 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLE, COUNTY OF CAPE MAY AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO PURCHASE LAND KNOWN AS A PORTION OF BLOCK 339, LOT 3, ON THE OFFICIAL TAX MAP OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLE – Following second reading, hearing, and consideration for adoption, Ordinance 1365-10 was adopted on motion by \_\_\_\_\_ seconded by \_\_\_\_\_ and passed on roll call.

Complete Ordinance is on file in the Clerk’s Office.

WHEREAS, Kathryn Burke Sellers and Steven Sellers currently own the land known as Block 339, Lot 3 on the Official Tax Map of the Township of Middle;

WHEREAS, The Township Committee of the Township of Middle, in order to construct sanitary sewer infrastructure seeks a portion of the said property for use as a pump station; and;

WHEREAS, the parties have come to an amicable agreement to resolve a condemnation action whereby Kathryn Burke Sellers and Steven Sellers shall sell a portion of Block 339, Lot 3 to the Township of Middle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middle, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The land and structures on said land described in Exhibit “A” hereto shall be purchased for the amount of \$38,500.00 from Kathryn Burke Sellers and Steven Sellers and conveyed via a Deed. The Mayor of the Township of Middle is authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate this purchase.

SECTION 2. All other Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 3. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
