



Middle Township and Wildwood City police departments have been allocated federal funds, under the 2010 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant. These funds are allocated to departments based upon current crime statistics and population. These grants have been utilized in past years to purchase equipment and make advancements in technology. Without the JAG funding being made available to our departments, we would not be able to buy the equipment through normal budgeted funding.

Middle Township Police plans to use the 2010 JAG funds to institute a bicycle unit. This will enable our police department to be more responsive on a community level. In addition to the bicycle unit, the department will purchase a mobile data terminal for a police vehicle.
